From Our Pastor

As we journey beyond the celebration of Easter, our hearts are filled with joy and gratitude for the immense grace that God has bestowed upon us through Jesus Christ, our Risen Savior. Jesus' resurrection holds profound significance for all of us, shaping the core of our faith and offering hope. His triumph over death and sin extend the means of forgiveness and redemption for all. It provides us with assurance and hope for the future and signifies new life and transformation. In this season of renewal and rebirth, we should reflect upon the Wesleyan understanding of grace – Prevenient, Justifying, and Sanctifying – and how it resonates with the message of Easter.


